	[1] 1.2.1		Write thoughts or ideas to communicate with specific audiences (e.g., cards, letters, notes, lists).
	[1] 1.2.2		Write a variety of responses to text (e.g., response logs, journals).
Structures and Conventions	<b>PS W1.3</b>		<b>The student uses CONVENTIONS OF STANDARD ENGLISH to write and edit. Student can:</b>
	[1] 1.3.1		Write first name and last name with initial capitals and lowercase letters.
	[1] 1.3.2		Write a variety of simple sentences using capitalization and end punctuation (i.e., statement, question, exclamation).
